- I. **Call to Order** Chair Rick called the meeting to order at 5:15 pm.
Present: Alderperson Weix Jr., Alderperson Caylor, Alderperson Rick
Present Not Voting: Police Chief Bennett, Norb "Nubs" Ashbeck, Fire Chief Klug
Others: Mayor Hass, City Clerk Anderson-Malm, Alderperson Lass, Alderperson Fermanich (remote), Kathleen Woodward, Mark Woodward, Jeff Klapperich, Merrill Community Media
- II. **Public Comment** Alderperson Fermanich (remote) spoke about the deer population problem in the City.
- III. **Minutes from Previous Meeting**
 1. **Consider placing the minutes from the March 25 meeting on file.**
- Alderperson Caylor motioned to place minutes from March 25 on file.
Alderperson Weix seconded and the motion passed.
- IV. **Nuisance Complaints and Vouchers**
 1. **Nuisance Complaints** - DHO Ashbeck updated the committee with a complaint filed after publishing the agenda.
 2. **Discuss and consider approving the vouchers** - Alderperson Weix Jr. motioned to Approve. Alderperson Caylor seconded and the motion Passed.
- V. **General Agenda Items for Consideration**
 1. **Discussion and consideration regarding the deer population in the City of Merrill limits, including enforcement, higher fines for feeding deer, and other ideas for controlling the deer population in the city.** - Police Chief Bennett updated the committee with information. He said there were 2 complaints in 2023 and going back 8 years, there were 8 complaints regarding feeding deer. Items that could be explored are increasing/promoting areas open to hunting, opening areas for hunting, or offering kill tags issued by the DNR. However, no hunting can be done until that autumn. The areas for hunting would be private property only and would be for bow hunting only. There could be open public areas and open nuisance areas could be determined. However, these would require re-wording of the ordinance and there would need to be ground rules in place. The committee discussed the issues involved with bow hunting in the City. Following further discussion, it was decided this would be brought back to the committee after the City Attorney is consulted as to how the ordinance could be modified. No further action was taken.

2. **Consider the change of agent application for Walgreens #10574, 101 N Center Avenue to Jeffry C. Klapperich.** - Alderperson Caylor motioned to Approve. Alderperson Weix Jr. seconded and the motion Passed.
3. **Consider a Class B liquor license for The Creative Spirit LLC, 129 N Prospect Street.** - Kathleen Woodward and Mark Woodward were given floor privileges to explain The Creative Spirit LLC. They stated this would be an arts & crafts center workshop where artists could offer classes. People participating in the class could purchase beer or wine while crafting. Following a brief discussion, Alderperson Caylor motioned to Approve. Alderperson Weix Jr. seconded and the motion Passed.
4. **Consider a street use permit for Gesundheit Saloon, 1300 E Main St for May 18, 2024, from 5:00 pm until 11:00 pm.** - Alderperson Caylor motioned to Approve. Alderperson Weix Jr. seconded and the motion Passed.
5. **Consider a street use permit for Gesundheit Saloon, 1300 E Main Street, for August 17, 2024, from 11:00 am until 11:00 pm, in conjunction with the 150th Anniversary of the bar celebration.** - Alderperson Caylor motioned to Approve. Alderperson Weix Jr. seconded and the motion Passed.

AN ORDINANCE

The Common Council of the City of Merrill, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 26, Article II, Section 26-21 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Merrill is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 26-21. Regulation of firearms, crossbows, bows, and explosives; hunting.

- (a) *Definitions.* The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Firearm means a weapon that acts by force of gunpowder.

- (b) *Discharging firearms and other weapons.*

- (1) No person shall fire or discharge any firearm, rifle, hand gun, air gun, crossbow or bow and arrow in the city.

- (c) *Exceptions.* This section shall not apply to the following:

- (1) A law enforcement officer while engaged in official duties;
- (2) The maintenance and use of city-approved supervised rifle or pistol ranges, shooting galleries or firearm, rifle air gun or handgun safety courses;
- (3) The firing or discharging of BB guns upon private premises by persons over 16 years or persons under such age under the direct personal supervision of a parent or guardian;
- (4) The discharge of a firearm or the other use of weapons as allowed under Wis. Stats. § 939.45;
- (5) The discharge of a shotgun, muzzle loader, pistol, crossbow or bow and arrow only as permitted by the state department of natural resources on lands owned by the state department of natural resources;

- (6) The discharge of a crossbow or bow and arrow on property with consent of the property owner and in a manner in which the flight of the bolt or arrow does not leave the property or otherwise endanger the safety of any other persons or the property of another;
 - (7) The discharge of a weapon by a person as authorized by a special resolution passed by the city common council for a specific area, purpose and limited to a specific duration of time.
- (d) *Explosive devices; permit required.* No person shall discharge or detonate any dynamite, nitroglycerin or other explosive within the city without first obtaining a permit to do so from the chief of police.
- (e) *Hunting regulated.* Hunting is prohibited within the corporate limits of the City of Merrill on lands owned or controlled by the city, **except as authorized by the Chief of Police**. Persons hunting on city owned forest land in the Town of Schley and lands owned by the state within the city shall be required to observe all hunting regulations established by the state department of natural resources and subject to the regulations of this article.
- (f) *Exception; wildlife overpopulation.*
 - (1) The common council may designate certain areas of the city as being so overpopulated with certain forms of wildlife, such as deer, that it may designate those areas as animal nuisance areas, and allow the hunting and destruction of the nuisance animals within that area which are owned or controlled by the city.
 - (2) Prior to doing this, the common council shall order the following:
 - a. Give notice, conduct a hearing and make findings upon that hearing as to whether or not there is sufficient evidence to warrant the designation of a nuisance animal area.
 - b. Consult with, and if necessary, obtain any necessary permit or authorization from the state and federal government.
 - c. If any area is designated as a nuisance animal area, the common council shall adopt rules governing the destruction of the animals in that area to ensure that it is done safely and in accordance with any permits or regulations of the state or federal government.

The common council shall also set the limits of the area together with the times that the destruction will be conducted to include the type of weapons and what persons will be doing the elimination.
- (g) *Use of weapons while hunting—Regulated.*
 - (1) No person may discharge a firearm or air gun except as otherwise permitted by the City of Merrill, while hunting within the City of Merrill.
 - (2) No person may fire a crossbow or bow and arrow except as otherwise permitted by the City of Merrill while hunting within the City of Merrill and is also required to comply with the following additional restrictions while hunting:
 - a. The person who hunts with a crossbow or bow and arrow, must discharge the bolt or arrow towards the ground in a downward flight from the point of discharge to target animal.
 - b. The person must have the permission of all property owners and owners of all permanent structures used for human occupancy, including a manufactured home, with 100 yards of the point of discharge.

Section 2. Severability. In the event any section, subsection, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance. It is the legislative intent of the Common Council that this ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal provision had not been included or any illegal application had not been made.

Section 3. Repeal and Effective Date. All ordinances or parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.

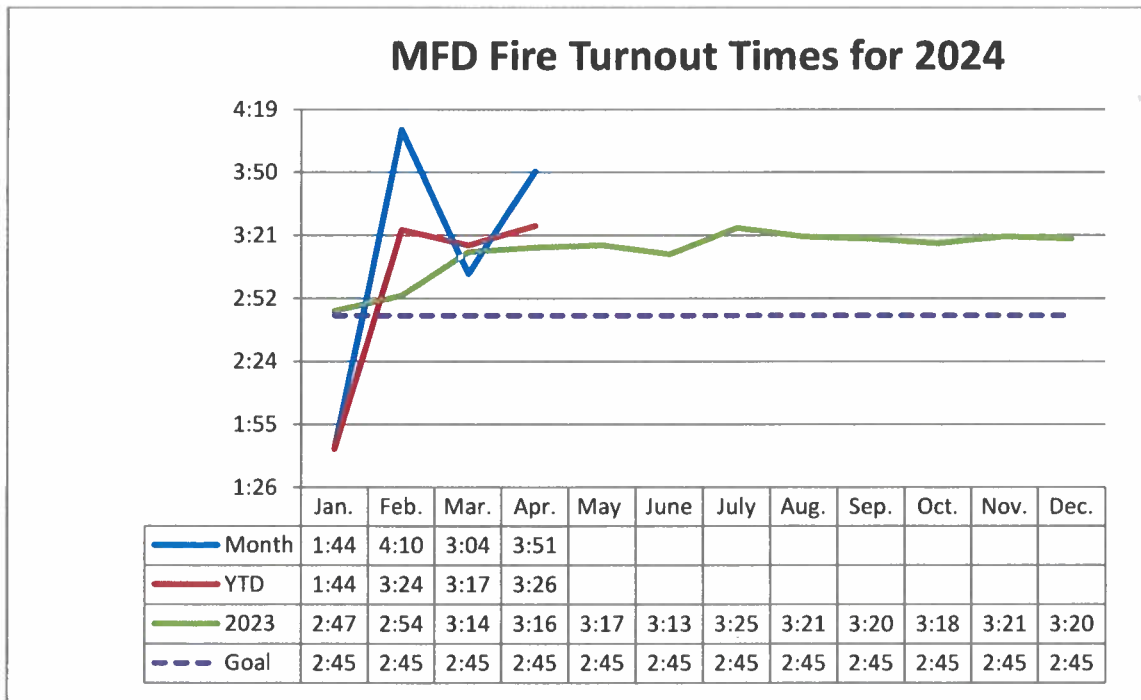
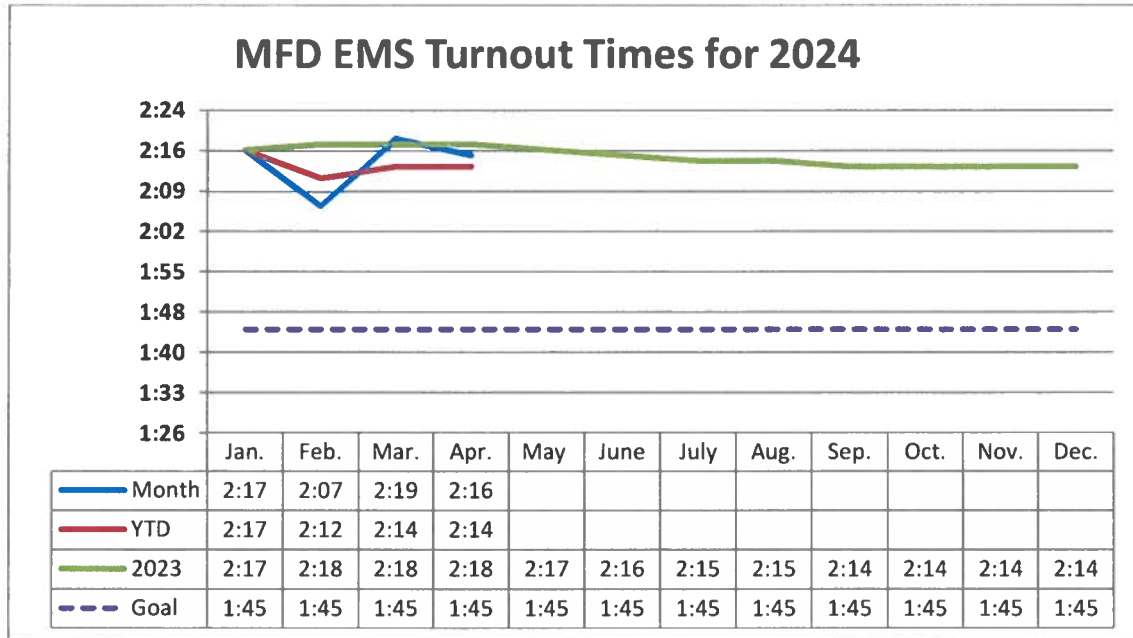
