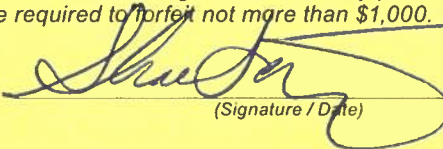

Listed below are the options for beer and liquor service both inside and outside the Smith Center for a special event in August. To my knowledge, at this time Merrill Hockey maintains a full liquor license for the Smith Center building only.

- 1.) If Merrill Hockey maintains existing beer/wine/liquor licensing in the Smith Center:
 - Only Merrill Hockey can serve within the Smith Center with licensed bartenders and their beer/liquor/wine stock. Licensed bartenders, of course, may also bartend elsewhere in the City too. **AND**
 - Merrill Hockey can apply for an extension of premises to serve outside of the Smith Center in a defined area of the MARC, with specified controls (wrist banding, ID'ing, no glass, trash receptacles, etc). This extension request would need approval by the Health and Safety Committee in June and Council approval by July if it is to be ready for an August event. **OR**
 - A non-profit, bona fide club, society, chamber of commerce, etc. could apply for a temporary license to serve beer/wine outside of the Smith Center premise in a defined area of the MARC with licensed bartenders. Again, this would only permit beer and wine, NO LIQUOR service is possible under a temporary license. This temporary license request would need approval by the Health and Safety Committee in June and Council approval by July if it is to be ready for an August event.
- 2.) If Merrill Hockey does not maintain its existing licensing:
 - A non-profit, bona fide club, society, chamber of commerce, etc. could apply for a temporary license to serve beer/wine inside and outside of the Smith Center in a defined area of the MARC with licensed bartenders. Again, this would only permit beer and wine, NO LIQUOR service is possible under a temporary license. This temporary license request would need approval by the Health and Safety Committee in June and Council approval by July if it is to be ready for an August event.

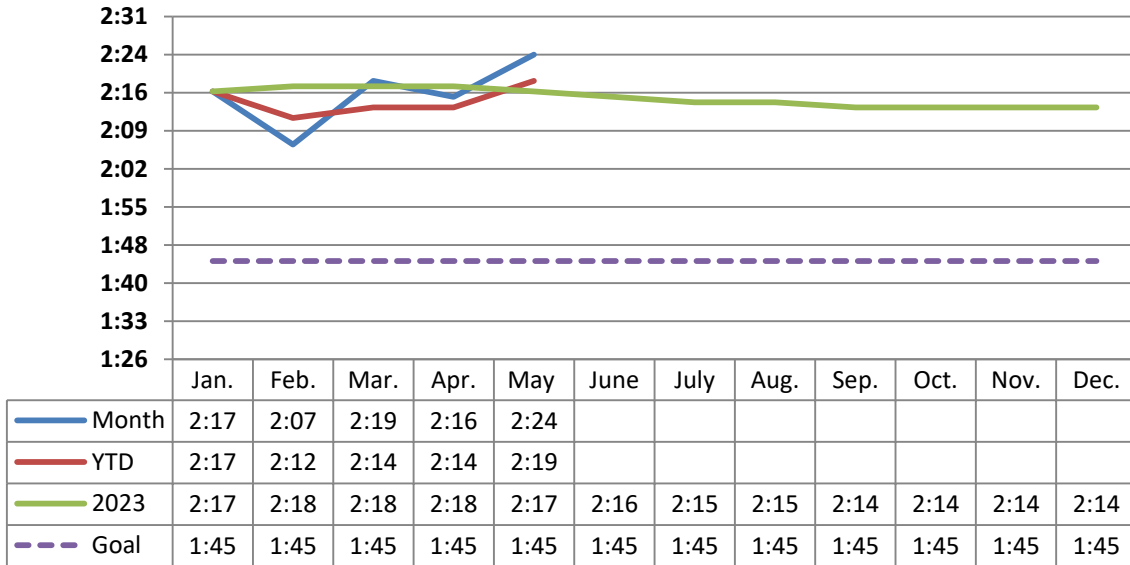

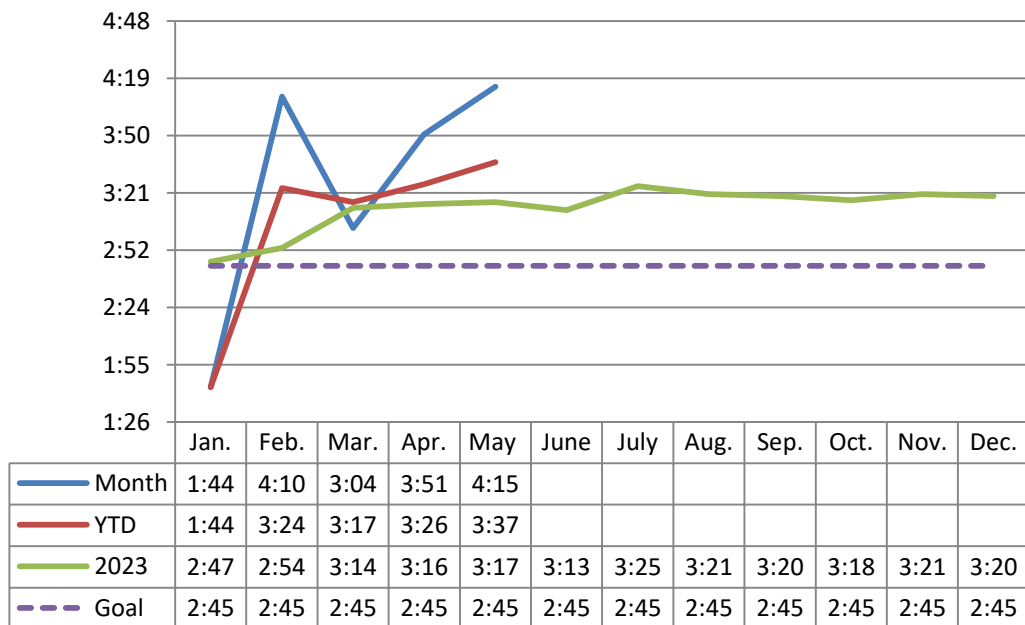
Turnout Time*

May 2024

Animals:

The number of incoming animals is increasing compared to this time last year.

We have also seen an increase in public animals being brought in for quarantine due to bite incidents. We are working with a local veterinarian to increase the low-cost vaccine clinics offered at LCHS. This will help the public afford the vaccines and allows quarantine to be provided at home (if the animal is up to date on its rabies vaccine).

We also hosted an exotic-animal surrender event with a rescue from Appleton. They accept many varieties of exotic pets, and it saves the shelter from having to care for animals that we may not have the supplies or expertise to work with. More than 30 animals were brought to the rescue organization at that event. They will host another event at LCHS in 2025.

Staff:

The staff is doing well.

Events:

Gazebo Night Raffles: July 25 & August 22

Craft Sale: September 28 at Pine River Town Hall.

Banquet: October 12th. Tickets go on sale on August 1st.

Financials:

We have been approved for several grant projects – a low-cost spay/neuter program for outdoor cats in Lincoln County, improved kennels at the shelter, and adoption incentives. These grants combined have resulted in almost \$10,000 for LCHS.

We are working with Gus Caylor to follow up about Gazebo Night fundraisers. We have enough volunteers to cover both events.

We have already received several great prizes for the Banquet.
