PURPOSE

The Merrill Fire Department (MFD) strives to be pro-active and present in the Merrill community in regards to public relations and non-emergent prevention services. The desire for the MFD to provide these services was abundantly clear at the department's 2024 strategic planning process. Staffing and duty day hours have made it challenging to fulfill the various requests while still maintaining an effective response force. Record calls for service as well as maintenance of training, station duties, equipment checks, and physical fitness all contribute to the challenge of providing public relations and non-emergent services.

GUIDELINE

Dedicated standbys are events that require specific personnel, apparatus, and/or equipment to be on scene in order for the event to run. Typically off-duty staff will be used since the event cannot happen without them. These standbys may or may not require compensation from the event host.

Non-dedicated standbys are events that we may or may not attend based on staffing and other daily FD functions. Typically on-duty would be used for these events depending on the date, time, location, duration, and nature of the event. If on-duty is used and they had to leave, it would not impact the event. Employees may volunteer to attend a non-dedicated standby event, as to not be subjected to duty day provisions.

Fire extinguisher training will be conducting using a train-the-trainer method. Interested individuals can contact MFD to schedule a time to be trained on fire extinguisher prop. Once trained, they can then borrow the prop and conduct training with their respective group, business, or organization. The fire extinguisher prop sign-out procedure should be used.

Smoke detector installation program will primarily be handled with on-duty personnel. They will utilize either the American Red Cross or Professional Firefighters of Wisconsin Charities program.

Full CPR classes for the public will be handled in-person, scheduled by & completed by an off-duty CPR instructor. Online, practical testing CPR courses will be scheduled by Administrative Assistant and completed by on duty CPR instructors.

Fire station tours will be primarily handled by on-duty staff.

Firefighter Combat Challenge Team Bonders that are requested will utilize at least 2 off-duty personnel. This will help assure that the event can take place in the event on duty staff are called away. Additionally these events typically take place outside of duty day hours.

First aid station at the fair will utilize a combination of on-duty and off-duty MFD staff. This will be based on needs and requests of the fair board. It may also include the use of volunteer emergency first responder groups.

Show & Tell events are ones typically made by various organizations or businesses in the community to attract people to their event. We try accommodate these requests within duty day hours and will be provided for no more than one hour. If possible, MFD staff will try to incorporate a safety lesson or skill at the event as part of the Show & Tell.

Stop the Bleed classes and training may still be given, however, the public should be directed to contact local hospital, emergency management, and/or North Central RTAC. We may still run the course or assist another organization run the course. This could be done with off-duty or on-duty depending on multiple factors like ones already listed in this document.

Community Care (Paramedic) Program is identified and handled in SOP M-11.

Adult and youth public educations classes will continue to be offered using on-duty staff pending any unforeseen factors.

PROCEDURE

When a public relations or non-emergent services request is made, line staff should forward the request to the Administrative Assistant, shift commander, and/or Chief. The accepting individual will consult the MFD I Am Responding calendar to determine availability, the work trade book to determine staffing, and this SOP to determine next appropriate actions. At any time if there is confusion or concern about handling a request, the fire chief shall be consulted and give final direction.

Position Purpose:

The purpose of this position is to serve as Director of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) with the responsibility of performing professional level work in planning, coordinating, monitoring, evaluating and overseeing the operations of emergency medical care while ensuring compliance with applicable statutes and administrative rules. The incumbent is also responsible for maintaining and obtaining up-to-date approvals for the State of Wisconsin approved operational plan. The Division Chief is the liaison and subject matter expert for all ambulance activities and billing. Additionally the purpose of this position is to lead, manage, and administer all aspects of the fire service, rescue, and EMS training including continuing education and standard compliance training.

Principal Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Maintains a leadership role while exhibiting attributes to include self-motivation, attention to detail and superb organization skills. Serves as primary department manager overseeing and coordinating critical care paramedic, TEMS, and community paramedic initiatives.
2. Provides direction to fire personnel in the administration of the EMS Program. May supervise employees to include: prioritizing and assigning work; conducting performance evaluations; ensuring staff are trained and developed, and making hiring, termination and disciplinary recommendations.
3. Coordinates and oversees all EMS training which could account for EMS refresher requirements as indicated by policy, protocol, and licensure. Assists and helps direct members in the proper process for maintaining licensure and credentialing within the EMS field.
4. Advances the Department through appropriate training by planning, preparing and presenting EMS educational programs with objectives and content which ensures compliance with State and Department programs and requirements. Oversees and/or records all completed training.
5. Develops and implements continuous quality improvement (CQI) programs by reviewing and analyzing EMS effectiveness, system trends, and needs, in an effort to ensure EMS system excellence. Continuously analyzes deployment of EMS resources and makes recommendations for any system modifications to enhance response.
6. Assists in researching and developing policies, protocols and procedures, to include analyzing, drafting, coordinating preparation and implementation.
7. Manages fire department ambulance licensure requirements and other related certifications in accordance with State and National Registry requirements and maintains records related to certifications.
8. Knows, understands and appropriately updates the EMS operational plan with the State of Wisconsin.

9. Supervises and assists the cleaning and maintenance of equipment and station as necessary.
10. Ensures all medical equipment on ambulances and fire apparatus are appropriate and in good working order and that medical supplies are at an appropriate inventory level.
11. Oversees and manages a variety of reports related to EMS and fire department operations to include the electronic Patient Care Report.
12. Performs duties of HIPPA Compliance Officer, Privacy Act Officer, and Infection Control program administrator.
13. Acts as liaison between Merrill Fire Department and county ambulance billing specialist serving as the Department's subject matter expert for the City of Merrill to ensure compliance and billing practices.
14. Acts as the liaison between the appointed Medical Director and Merrill Fire Department for Continuous Quality Improvement, Quality Assurance, and licensure of personnel.
15. Staffs an ambulance at the Paramedic level to conduct periodic evaluations of personnel, in order to assess proficiency, or as needed in staff shortages.
16. Integrates health and safety plans, policies and procedures into daily work activities; ability to conduct initial accident and incident investigations.
17. Serves as a liaison for EMS-related issues with State and Local regulatory agencies, base hospital personnel, other EMS and fire agencies, medical equipment suppliers, training centers, citizens, and other agencies/individuals associated with pre-hospital care. Develops and maintains effective working relations, information sharing/dissemination, conflict resolution, and compliance with applicable regulations and policies.
18. Participates on appropriate committees as a representative for the Merrill Fire Department to ensure the Departments interests are represented or to advance the Department.
19. Provides guidance for specialty transport, multi-casualty response, and special events.
20. Assists with vehicle and equipment procurement within budgetary guidelines
21. Monitors and evaluates section expenditures, which includes: recommendation of budget items; evaluating past fiscal spending; anticipating future spending; and, performing other budget related activities.
22. Deals with public inquiries and concerns according to policy and procedure. Provides emergency medical services education to city employees and public as needed.
23. Researches and identifies grant opportunities in the area of EMS and be able to persuasively communicate the Merrill Fire Department's mission in developing, writing and submitting grant proposals to third-party entities.
25. Assists in preparing plans that outline operating procedures to be used in response to disasters/emergencies.
26. Maintain the professional standards for all fire department personnel. This includes reviewing the applicable standards, regulations and requirements and identifying the need for compliance and workplace development.
27. In coordination with the Battalion Chiefs and emergency service instructors, plan and/or conduct regularly scheduled exercises in fire service and rescue disciplines.
28. Develop lesson plans, lesson outlines, and training in accordance with set standard operating procedures and policies.
29. Responsible for properly tracking employee fire service and rescue training. Maintain electronic training files for all members and all training programs. Produce monthly and annual reports of training performance.
30. Maintain thorough knowledge of the agency's apparatus and the tools and equipment carried on them.

31. Continually evaluate best practices to refine, revise, enhance, improve, and update training programs and related content.
32. Ensure compliance with state and federal regulations, national standards, and best practices such as (but not limited to) OSHA, ISO, NFPA, DSPS, and the City's Insurance carrier.
33. Develop and manage task books for Recruit Firefighter/Paramedics and Temporary Supervisor positions.
34. Maintain memberships in professional associations. Attend conferences and seminars which support this position.
35. May act in place of and assume duties of the fire chief in their absence.

Additional Duties and Responsibilities:

- Other duties as may be necessary to fulfill the responsibilities of this position.
- Perform duties of a Battalion Chief as needed.

Work Relationships and Scope:

Reports to: Fire Chief

Supervises: The whole department through training and EMS requirements as listed above.

Work Relationships: Works very closely with Merrill Fire/EMS department employees, City Employees, other fire departments and EMR groups, ER hospital staff, and the public. Work is performed under the general supervision of the shift Battalion Chief.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities, Qualifications Required:

Education, Experience, and Qualifications:

This position requires a minimum of five years of full-time firefighting and EMS experience supplemented by an associate's degree in fire science, EMS, public administration, or other related field. The following licenses and certifications are required:

- State of Wisconsin or nationally accredited Fire Officer I.
- State of Wisconsin licensed or Nationally Registered EMT - Paramedic. TEMS and Critical Care endorsements are preferred.
- Emergency Services Instructor I.
- National Incident Management System (NIMS) certifications in ICS-700, 100, 200, 300, 400.
- Incident Safety Officer.
- Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), and Pediatric Life Support (PALS) certifications.
- Candidates must also possess a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record.

The following licenses and certifications are required within 4 years:

- Emergency Services Instructor II.
- State of Wisconsin or nationally accredited Fire Officer II.
- American Heart Association BLS Instructor.

The following are desired educational and experience qualifications:

- Substantial experience as a trainer or teacher within EMS and/or fire service.
- Supervisory experience within leadership positions.
- Advanced Cardiac Life Support for Experience Provider (ACLS-EP) Instructor.
- A bachelor's degree in fire science, EMS, public administration or other related field.

Skills/Abilities:

- Ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
- Knowledge of methods and procedures of managing Emergency Medical Services
- Knowledge of rules and regulations governing the operations of ambulance services.
- Knowledge of the principles of personnel management including recruiting, retention, training, and discipline
- Knowledge of effective methods of supervision and ability to manage staff effectively.
- Knowledge of the National Incident Management System
- Knowledge of basic and Advanced Life Support practices and procedures, and HIPAA regulations and procedures
- Proficient knowledge of Microsoft Office or other related products and tools
- Ability to work under extremely stressful situations.
- Ability to analyze and categorize data and information using established criteria, in order to determine consequences and to identify and select alternatives.

 - *(with one less person at the station from Monday – Friday, we have one less person who could respond if necessary. We also then have one less person for backfills during the times they are not scheduled to work).

 - * Jan. – Aug. 2022: 68% fire backfill response vs. Jan. – Aug. 2023: 59% fire backfill response
 - *Oct. '21 – Aug. '22: 910 callbacks filled vs. Oct. '22 – Aug. '23: 835 callbacks filled. **Meaning we had 75 fewer backfills due to not having Administrative BC**

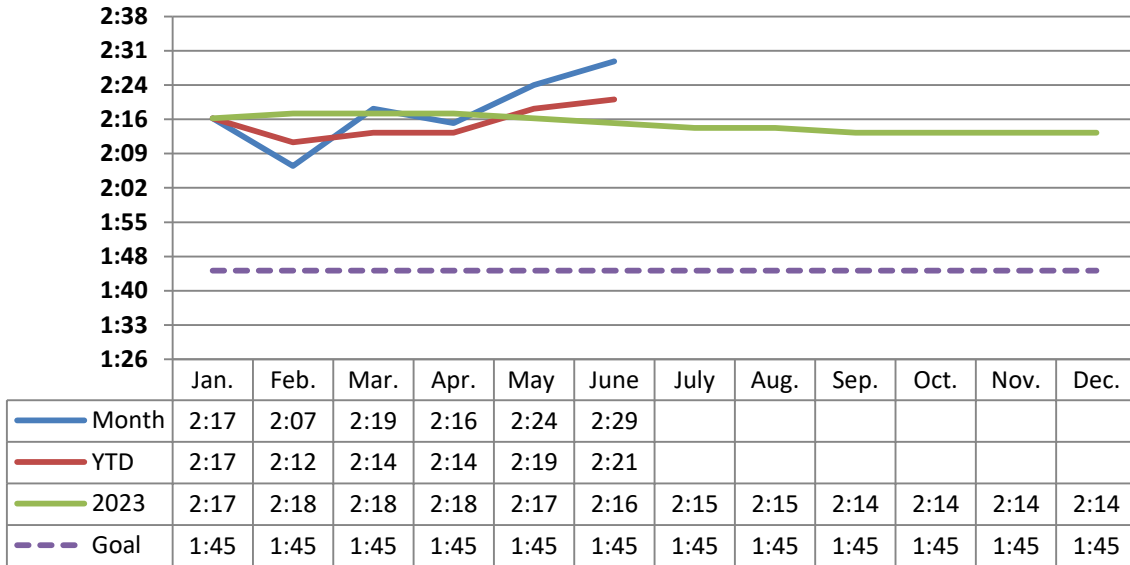

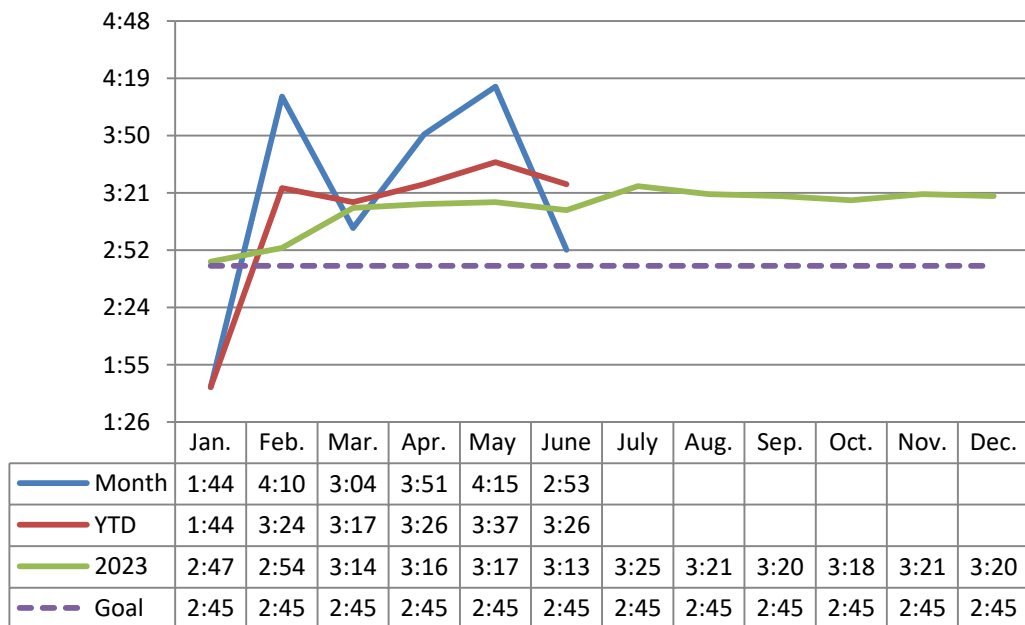
Turnout Time*

- B-shift completed a "Safe Place for Newborns" class taught by an outside instructor. We are currently working with the instructor for both of the other shifts to obtain the same class either in-person or virtually.
