NFPA 1710 sets the standard for turnout time at 60 seconds for EMS calls and 80 seconds for fire calls. Using 90th percentile gives an accurate snapshot of these calls. An emergent response indicates the use of lights and sirens to a call and the responding time is less than 6 minutes
