- III. **Minutes from Previous Meeting**

The motion passed.



Any violations (few) were minor, mainly lack of knowledge situations, not intentional violations. Most operators appeared to be seasoned with knowledge of what is needed to comply.

The large tents were equipped with one fire extinguisher each. With size of tents, a minimum of two for each tent should be on board with a distance between not to exceed 75'. Tents were flame resistant material as required.

Inspector requested two individuals to extinguish cigarettes due to no smoking on the grounds

Spacing of vendors (minimum of 10') – provided a good situation and should continue for repeat event.

### **AUDIT FINDINGS:**

A substantial compliance audit of the **MERRILL FIRE DEPT** for the 2% fire dues program was conducted on **04/22/2025**. The audit was to confirm compliance with the SPS 314 and State Statute 101.575 (6), all-inclusive for the year 2024. The audit generally consisted of reviewing inspection, prevention, public education and training records along with fire reports and other fire department statutory requirements.

Substantial compliance, as prescribed by chapter SPS 314 Administrative Code and for the purposes of s. 101.575 (4) (a) 1. and 2., Wis. 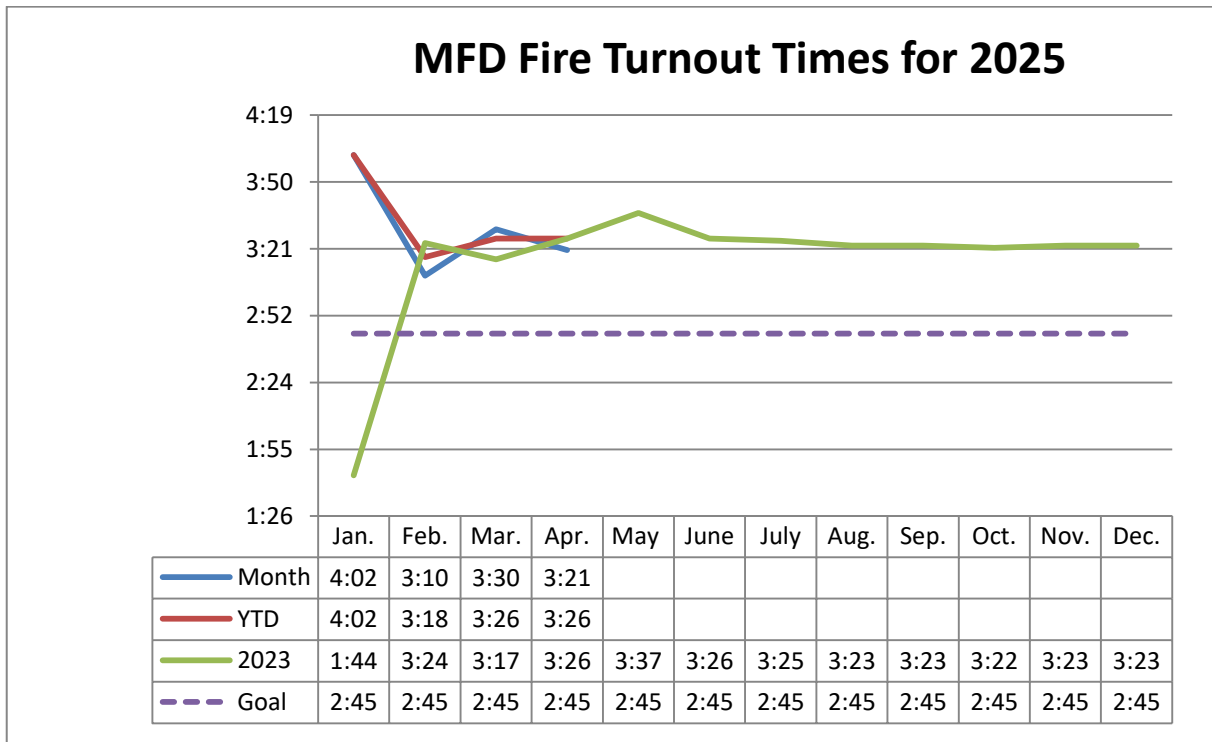
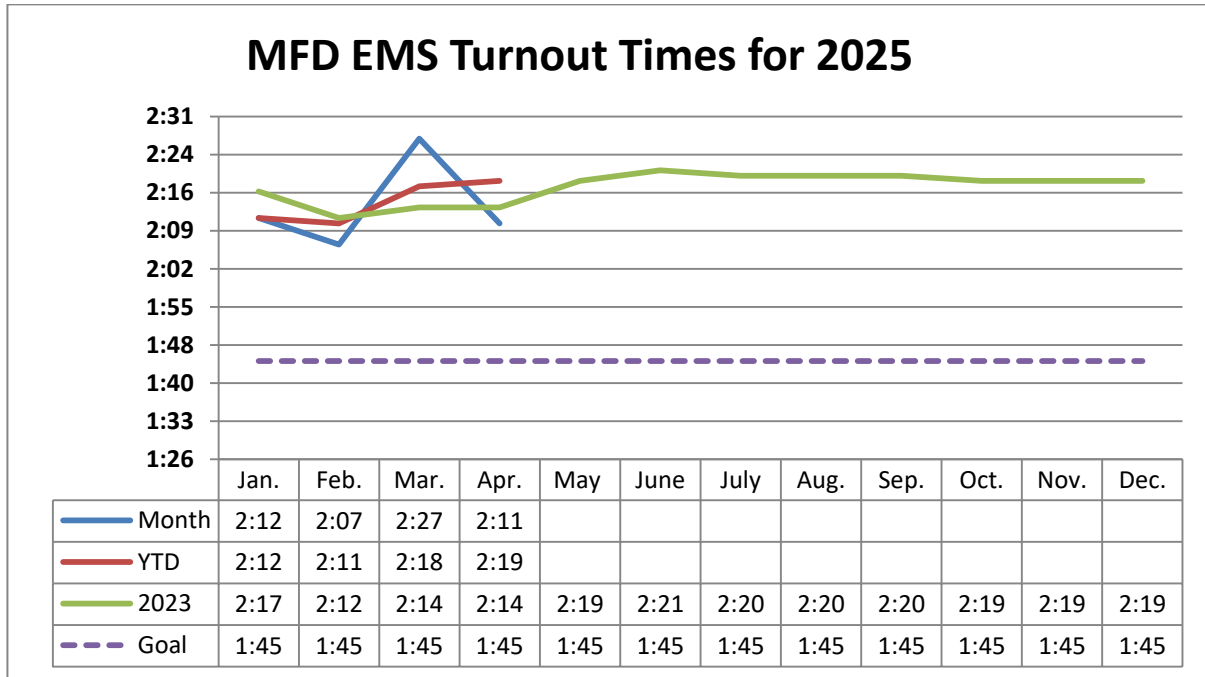
